Victoria's COVIDSafe setting restrictions: Victoria returned to COVIDSafe from 11:59pm on Friday 26 February 2021

What does this mean I can do?

- You can have up to 30 visitors to your home per day, meaning the household members plus up to 30 visitors (excluding children under 12 months of age, and intimate partners of anyone living in your house).
- You must always carry a face mask with you when you leave home unless you have a lawful reason not to wear a mask.
- You can return to work if you cannot work from home. In addition, up to 75 per cent of office-based workers can return to onsite work.

Under COVIDSafe restrictions, community services and local government facilities in Victoria can operate as follows:

- Record keeping is required for all community facilities no matter what density limit is applied. For venues that use the two square metre rule, electronic record keeping must be used. Otherwise the four square metre rule applies where manual record keeping is used.
- Libraries and toy libraries can operate and must apply the density limit. No group limits apply.
- Community facilities are open and must apply the density limit. No group limits apply.
- Examples of other community facilities are:
 - community centres and halls
 - men's sheds
 - public libraries (including toy libraries)
 - youth centres
 - Police and Community Youth Clubs (PCYCs)
 - community clubs
 - RSL clubs (sporting facilities component).
